

Literacy

SPAG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar): Sessions will continue to focus on key sentence features such as full stops and capital letters, and also working on enriching our writing with adjectives and different tenses.

Storytelling and reflections: Our extended writing will focus on plan-draft-edit-publishing a piece of fiction. We will then reflect on the past year and write about the different changes that have occurred in our lives.

Art

Children will observe pieces of art from all over the world; for example, the work of Tanzanian artist Tinga Tinga. We will be looking at how the artist uses line, shape and colour, and what emotions are evoked by the paintings. Children will create their own pieces in a similar style.

IPC

The topic 'Our World' will see the Hedgehogs dedicating a week to each world continent and learning about their respective cultures and traditions. We also will zone in on London and explore its history from past to present day.

PE

The Hedgehogs will have swimming lessons every Wednesday afternoon and a P.E. Lesson with Mr. Patterson every Thursday morning. Please note that on Thursdays the children can wear their P.E. Kits to school and pack their uniform in their bag to change into.

Maths Mastery

We will be consolidating recognition of numbers between 50 and 100 and working on our knowledge of place value to add and subtract bigger numbers.

The focus will then shift to working with money. This will encompass coin recognition and using money in the real world (for example, getting change.) The term will finish with an introduction to multiplication and division, followed by a unit on capacity and volume.

ICT

Children will be working on Beebots/iPads, learning about programming and instructions, and using their knowledge of position, direction and movement.

How you can support your child's learning this term:

Changes: Children will discuss the ways in which they have changed this academic year both in their appearance and in their abilities. Circle time will focus on how change can be a very positive and exciting thing.
