(more on that to follow).

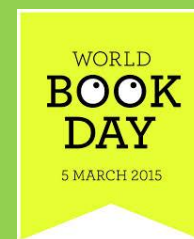
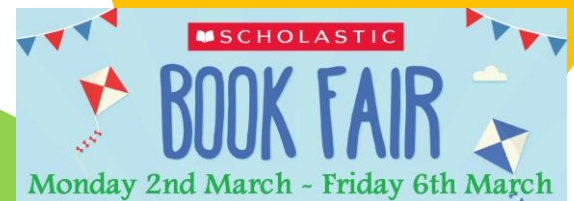
But before all that is **Book Week**
