

## Literacy

This term we will link our writing with our IPC topics. We will use the first topic of Going Global to practice our persuasive writing techniques. We will be writing a newspaper article all about the use of sweat shops across the world, focusing on sentences structure and advanced punctuation. We will continue to practice grammar each day and will develop our inference skills in reading sessions. We will write some non fiction reports all about dinosaurs as part of our Out of Africa topic and will focus on the organisation and clarity of our writing. We will end the term by using our creative minds to write some fantastic poetry using imagery and personification!

## Art (IPC)

In groups we will be designing and making our own t-shirt. This will link in with our work on brands of the world and will help consolidate our design and painting skills. For Creative week, we will learn about the artist Frieda Kahlo, creating our own self portraits.

## IPC

Our topic in Spring 1 is Going Global. In this unit of work Year 6 will learn about globalisation and what it means for us. We will investigate and research the advantages and disadvantages of tourism and create our own brochure advertising our local area. We will investigate where our food and clothes comes from, thinking carefully about the conditions that workers have to live and work in. We will research attitudes to brands of the world, creating our own questionnaire, using our collected data to make conclusions. In Spring 2 we will learn about how the world came to be, starting with the evolution of bacteria and plants. We will research dinosaurs and how they lived and how they evolved over the years. We will learn about how fossils can tell us so much about the past and will make our own fossil. This will lead us on to the evolution of humans and how we have changed over many years.

## Maths

Year 6 will continue to work hard in maths, with a particular focus on using and applying the maths skills they know. As part of our work on shape we will learn how to rotate and transform a shape. Dolphins will learn about 4 quadrant grids and how to plot coordinates on a grid. We will learn how to find a missing angle on a shape and how to calculate the area and perimeter of an irregular shape. We will learn how to find the volume of a cube or cuboid. We will start our work on algebra and look at how data can be presented in a variety of ways. We will create our own pie chart and bar charts. We will look at time and time word problems and how we solve problems using brackets.
