

## Literacy

**SPAG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar):** Sessions will continue to focus on key sentence features such as full stops and capital letters, and also working on enriching our writing with adjectives and different tenses.

**Storytelling and reflections:** Our extended writing will focus on plan-draft-edit-publishing a piece of fiction and non-fiction. We will continue using the Talk 4 Writing process to enrich our experiences with a story.

## Art

Children will observe pieces of art from all over the world; for example, the work of Tanzanian artist Tinga, Tinga. We will be looking at how the artist uses line, shape and colour, and what emotions are evoked by the paintings. Children will create their own pieces in a similar style.

## IPC

The topic 'Our World' will explore other countries to learn about their respective cultures and traditions. We also will zone in on London and our local area and explore what makes it unique. We will study plants and their growth cycle. In the second half term, we will study animals.

## PE

The Badgers will have swimming lessons every Wednesday afternoon and PE lessons will continue on Monday mornings. Hedgehogs will also continue to have their usual Monday morning PE session, with the addition of a dance lesson every Thursday.

## Maths Mastery

We will be consolidating recognition of numbers between 50 and 100 and working on our knowledge of place value to add and subtract bigger numbers.

The focus will then shift to working with money. This will encompass coin recognition and using money in the real world (for example, making change). The term will finish with an introduction to multiplication and division, followed by a unit on capacity and volume.

IPC: Our World



## ICT

**Digital media:** children will be taking photographs and videos on cameras and other digital devices. We will be using the internet to find information and revising our e-safety.

How you can support your child's learning this term:

## Science

We will be looking at different species of animal and learning about where in the world they can be found and the ways in which they adapt to their surroundings. Children will also have the opportunity to plant and nurture their own plants, recording the conditions in which they grow the fastest.

## PSHE

**Changes:** Children will discuss the ways in which they have changed this academic year both in their appearance and in their abilities. Circle time will focus on how change can be a very positive and exciting thing.

## RE

**Festivals:** Children will be learning about the importance and role of celebrations across the different world faiths; for example, Eid-al-Fitr.
