For the last few weeks, children in Zebras, Tigers and Leopards class have been extremely busy practicing for the upcoming Foundation Stage Nativity.

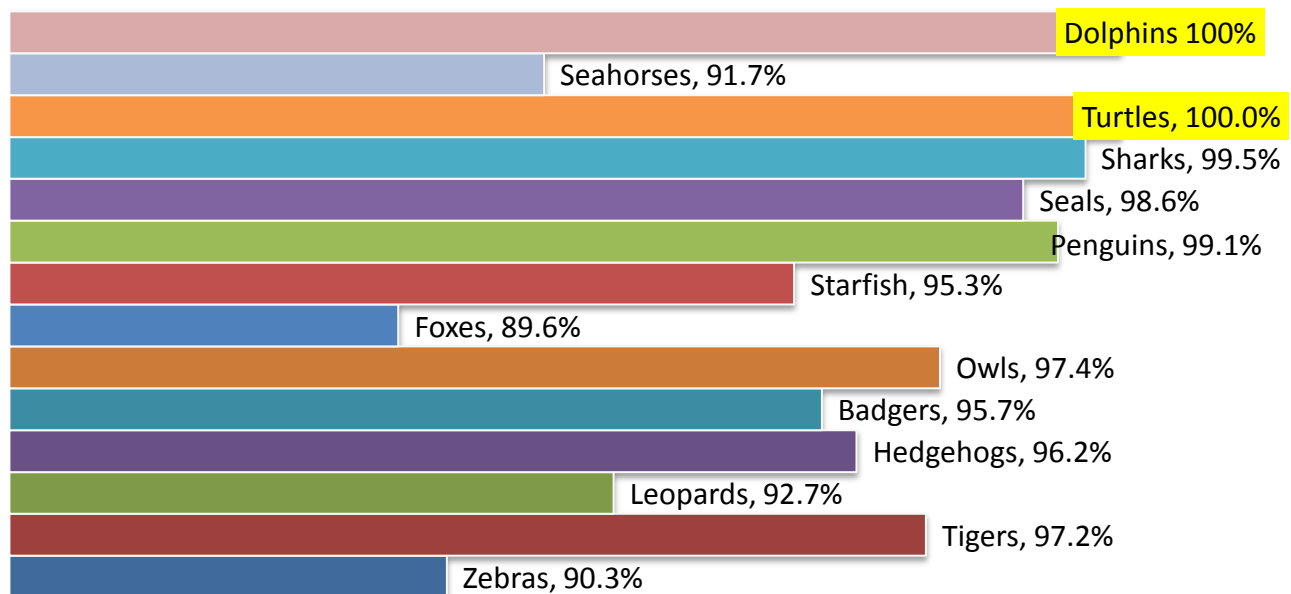
