As a Rights Respecting School, we like to focus our attentions on different articles of the Conventions on the Rights of the Child each month. One of the Rights of the Month for March is Article 24:

Article 24

Every child has the right to the best possible health with access to clean water and nutritious food.

As *the single most important thing* that can be done to help reduce the spread of illnesses such as cold, flu and tummy bugs, it is vitally important that all children are made aware of the importance and benefits of washing their hands properly. Please support us in this by encouraging your child to wash their hands at appropriate time such as after going to the toilet and before eating.

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind parents of the NHS guidance and School Policy that children with diarrhoea and/or vomiting must be kept off school for **48 hours after their symptoms have gone.**
