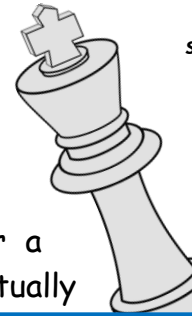
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## Welcome to this week's Shaftesbury Update

**Slap** on a hat



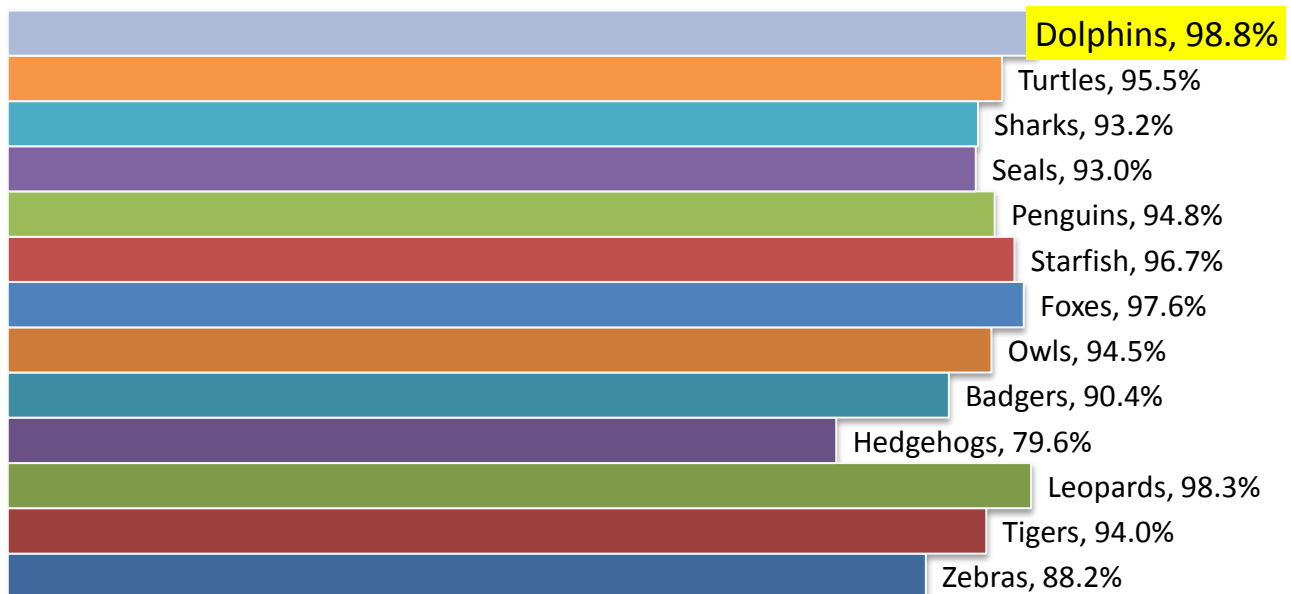
**Slop** on the 30+ sunscreen
