All donations should be brought to the School Office.

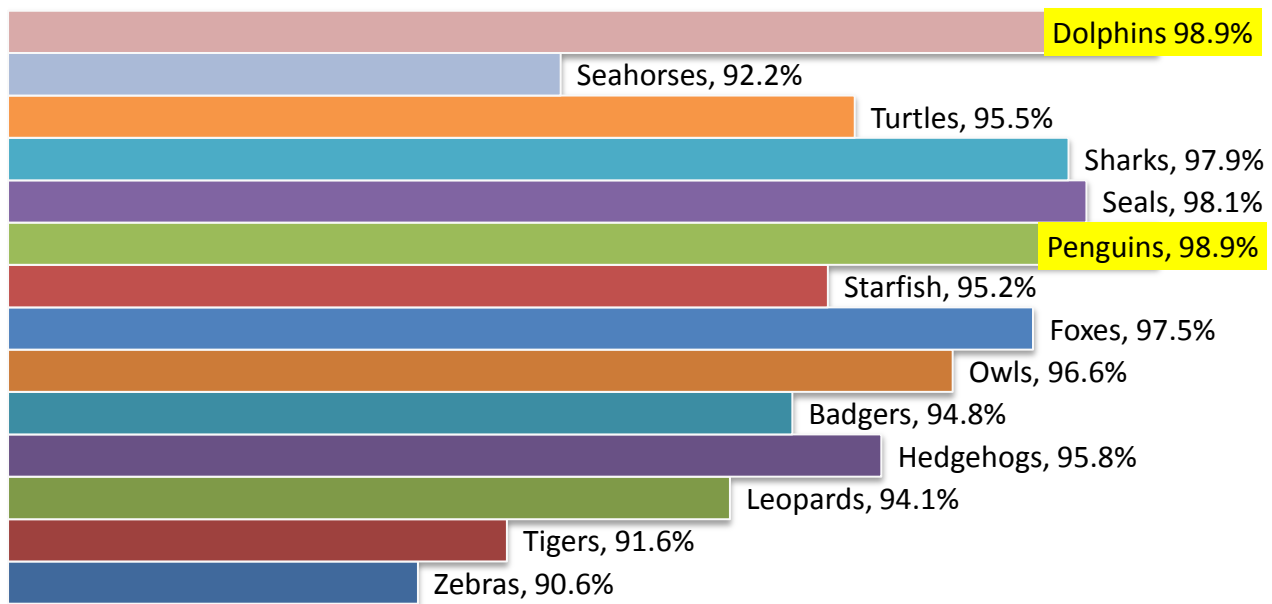
